Volunteer Drivers

Volunteer drivers use their own vehicles to transport seniors to doctor/medical appointments, the grocery store, or other locations like activities, beauty and barber shops.



Free Services Include:

Transportation, Loan of Medical Equipment, Minor Household Services, Repairs, and More.



The Senior Buddy System

For Seniors who can't safely leave their homes, this program provides them with a "Buddy Volunteer" who will provide access to groceries, prescriptions, and weekly check-in phone calls. Volunteers help their buddies keep a connection to others and their community while staying safe at home.

Group Van Rides

Senior Access provides weekly group van rides to locations such as Walmart, Target, the library, and Senior Access Activities.

Senior Access provides temporary access to expensive medical equipment to assist in times of illness or accident recovery.
